Before you commit to these classes, please be aware of our program policies:

Things to Consider

This class requires quite a bit of physical activity such as frequent movement from floor to standing position, walking, carrying your child (under the arms) from a squat to a standing position, and carrying your child while walking. This will be more of an issue for parents with children who are not yet walking with ease. Accompanying parent is strongly encouraged to participate as much as they are able. Disabilities will be accommodated with modified activities. Please wear comfortable clothing to class.

We will be taking pictures and video footage of the class. Please read the photo release form carefully and indicate your preferences.

A weekly assignment will be issued to you via email. These assignments will be unique to you depending on when you start classes and require daily music time together. Please prepare to set aside some time each day for this practice.

Socialization between parents may occur before and after the class, but talking should be minimal during class to help facilitate class activities, observation, and to help preserve the children's focus.

Payments/Fee Policy

Refunds will be granted until the first class. After that, tuition will be non-refundable.

Since there are two instructors for this class, it is unlikely that we would need to ever cancel for a reason other than weather. If we do, you will be contacted by email and credited for the cancelled class.

Payments are made in groups of 10 classes. Invoices for the next set of 10 classes will be issued via email after your 7th class has taken place. Payment for the next set of 10 classes will be due no later than the 10th class of the previous set of classes.

Weather/Illness Policy

In the event that you or your child should become ill, please do not come to the class. It will not be enjoyable for you or your child, and will risk infecting the other parents and children. Since the costs of holding class remain the same whether or not you attend, we regret that we are unable to grant any refunds for the class you miss.

In the event that weather should become too hazardous for travel, we will cancel class. A message will be posted on our website informing you of a cancellation and you will be credited one extra class.
